



Two Years of Funding

Hearts for the Invisible Charlotte Coalition (HFTICC) was first funded just two years ago, in May 2023, and since then, we have made a powerful impact in serving our unsheltered neighbors. With this vital support, we've expanded our reach, provided critical outreach services, and offered compassionate case management to those in need. In just two years, the difference we've made together shows the incredible power of community commitment and the urgent need for continued advocacy and support.

Neighbors Served

- **239** children, including 92 under the age of 5
- **187** seniors 55+
- **24** veterans
- **539** women
- **512** chronically homeless
- **617** with a mental health disorder
- **387** with a substance use disorder
- **404** with a chronic health condition
- **168** with a developmental disability
- **259** with a physical disability

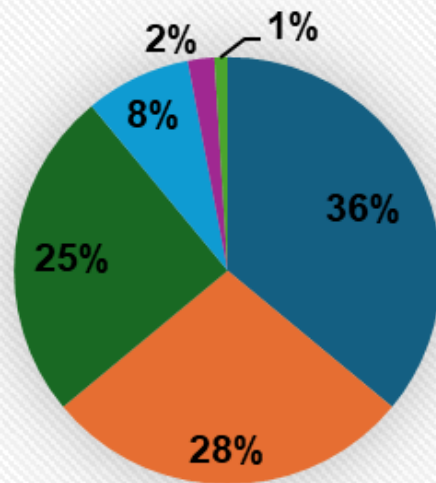

Permanent Exit Breakdown



- Permanent Supportive Housing
- Market Rate Housing
- Reunification with Friends/Family
- Rapid Rehousing
- Other Subsidized Housing
- Housing owned by client

- Exited 922 people since 5/1/2023. Of those, 214 discharged to permanent housing, 22%.
– That means, on average, we had 2 move-ins per week!
- An additional 318, 32% were discharged to emergency shelter, a treatment facility, transitional housing, or a hotel or motel not paid for by ES, ending their unsheltered homelessness.
- 85 people exited to permanent housing within 1 month of working with HFTICC.
- Overall, the data show that a diversity of options is needed to meet people’s housing needs. While PSH is needed, it is not the only option. Connections to friends and family (i.e., diversion) and affordable market rate housing remain very important.
